### Prizes

#### Instrumental

1st Place Prize - \$2,000 2nd Place Prize - \$1,000 Best Contemporary Prize - \$500

#### Vocal

1st Place Prize - \$2,000 2nd Place Prize - \$1,000 Best Contemporary Prize - \$500

## Eligibility

- Contestants must be current residents of San Diego County or Baja California.
- Contestants may be up to age 30 on the day of the competition.
- Contestants must provide their own accompanist and one original copy of sheet music for each selection for the judges. Digital printouts are acceptable with proof of purchase.

Application fee is \$35 per contestant.

## Repertoire

Instrumental and vocal contestants are encouraged to bring a mix of selections from contrasting periods that show their skill and musicality across a wide range of styles and eras. Contestants will be asked to play excerpts of their selections, and each audition typically runs about 15 minutes.

#### Instrumental

- Any 3 contrasting pieces by three different composers
- At least one piece must have been written after 1975
- At least one piece must be unaccompanied

#### Vocal

- One aria from a cantata, mass, passion, or oratorio to be performed in its original language
- One opera aria
- One selection of choice (art song, solo piece, piece with orchestra, etc.)
- At least one piece must have been written after 1975

# Performances

#### Winners Recital

All prize-winners are required to perform at the **Winners Recital** in the weeks following the competition. Date and time will be announced soon. Repertoire is at the discretion of the competition chairs and will be selected from prize-winners' competition performance material.

Award checks will be presented at the Winners Recital. Failure to perform at the recital may result in forfeiture of your award. A \$100 stipend will be provided for each accompanist performing at this recital.

### **Community Concerts**

Prize-winners may be invited to perform in La Jolla Symphony & Chorus's growing series of community concerts throughout San Diego County, including our free concerts at the various public library branches, retirement communities, and classroom settings.
